- ✓ Complying with all statutory requirements and standards and where these requirements do not exist, developing and applying standards that reflect the Company's commitment to safety.
- ✓ Using advances in technology to encourage innovative solutions to decrease exposure to potential hazards in the workplace.
- ✓ Providing information to all employees, contractors and visitors that inform them of safety and health issues relevant to the Company's operations.
- ✓ Regularly reviewing the Safety Management System to ensure both compliance with legislation and relevance in the current climate and to assist with the continuous improvement of the system.
- ✓ Set measurable targets for improvement in all areas of safety and health.
